to help children recognize the presence of God



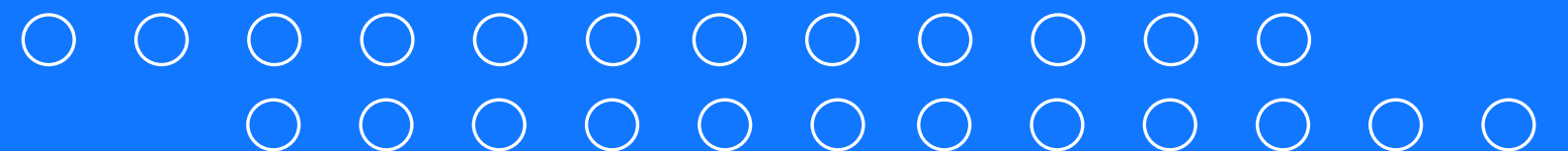
